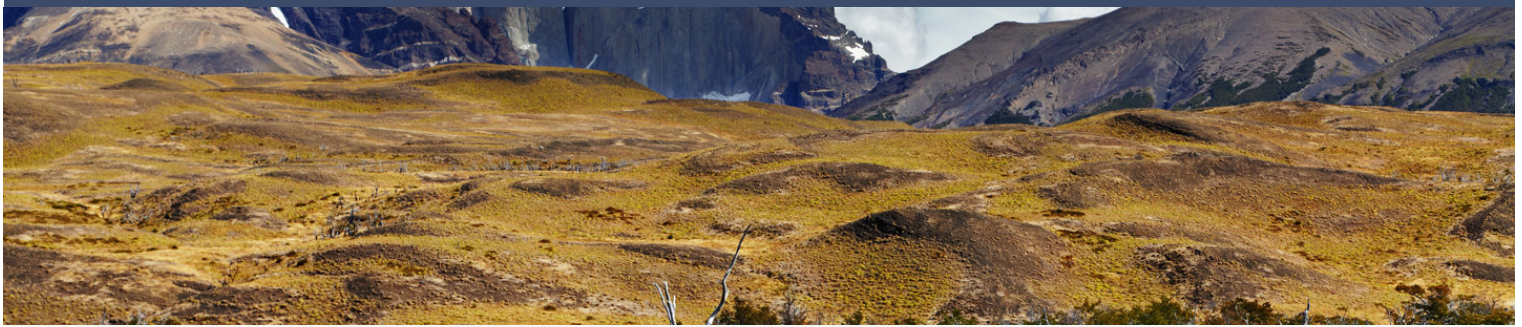

From Punta Arenas, you will be able to discover the Torres del Paine National Park. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it is one of the most beautiful places on Earth.

Le Boréal will then head to Tortel. This faraway village boasts unmatched architecture: stilt houses, wooden walkways, endless stairways...

You will be captivated at Puerto Montt by the incomparable beauty of the landscapes in this capital of the Lake District, and discover in Castro on Chiloe Island a remarkable Unesco architectural heritage.

At the end of your cruise you will land in the legendary port of Valparaiso. This will be your chance to discover this 'paradise valley' whose historic centre is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
